Overview of Practice

Notable cases to date include:

– Crime

R v H – Successfully prosecuted a complex housing fraud on behalf of a local authority.

R v F – Successfully prosecuted a child kidnapping.

R v S – Successfully defended an alleged knife-wielding incident on a bus.

R v B – Successfully defended in a £6,000,000+ trading standards fraud as the dismissal stage.

– Licensing, Housing and Planning

K v Local Authority – Successfully defended an appeal against a taxi licence revocation.

G v Local Authority – Successfully defended an appeal against a civil penalty (housing).

R (G, G & T Ltd) v Local Authority – Successfully defended a judicial review of a charging decision at the permission stage.

Local Authority v A, A, J Ltd & E Ltd – Successfully prosecuted an HMO with unsafe premises.
